We were made to worship. Worship is the right response to the presence of God. It is not confined to a place, but rather through Jesus, is embodied in the flesh and blood of his people. We are temples of worship, offering our bodies as living sacrifices holy and pleasing to God. Because our lives are worship, worship is for everywhere. Everywhere you go is a place of worship. The very breath in your lungs is worship, creation honoring its Creator by living out its function. Worship is standing in awe before God, recognizing his greatness, his wonder, and our appropriate submission.

Worship is for everything. We worship God for his creative power, his salvation through Jesus, and his redemption of our lives. We get to praise God in a variety of ways, through words, songs, music, dance, and ultimately through life itself. God is good, he is worthy of our attention, our reverence and our awe.

Worship is for everyOne. When you are being the person God made you to be, you are worshipping him. "Let everything that has breath praise the Lord." If there is breath in your lungs, worship is your calling. It gets us outside ourselves, acknowledges the one who is greater than us, greater than our circumstances, and greater than the chaos and confusion of our world. Worship centers us. It places God at the proper center of our life. The best thing you can do right now is worship. Take a moment and worship God.
